An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,600.00 to pay Refuel Incorporated for the cleaning of the City's underground fuel storage tanks, to approve the issuance by the Auditor of payment for an invoice from Refuel Incorporated in the amount of \$2,600.00 upon submission to him of a purchase order and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the City's underground fuel storage tanks accumulated bacteria and debris; and,

Whereas, the accumulation of these materials caused City vehicles to stop running. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,600.00 should be and hereby is appropriated to pay Refuel Incorporated for the cleaning of the City's underground fuel storage tanks.

Section 2. That the Auditor is hereby authorized to issue payment to Refuel Incorporated in the amount of \$2,600.00 upon submission to him of a purchase order.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for public health, safety and welfare, said emergency being the need to clean the fuel tanks in a timely manner to keep City vehicles operations, and shall take effect and be in force upon its signature by the Mayor.
