An Ordinance to amend Section 262.02(c)(9)B of the Administrative Code by the addition of subsection 3 authorizing compensatory time for overtime ~~effective from and after January 1, 2004~~ and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That Section 262.02(c)(9)B is hereby amended by the addition of subsection 3 as follows:

3. Compensatory Time. ~~From and after January 1, 2004,~~ <sup>A</sup> an employee may accumulate and maintain up to twenty-four (24) hours of compensatory time. The employee must notify the City each pay period to indicate that they want this earned overtime to be accumulated as compensatory time. Compensatory time off requests must be made in advance and are subject to supervisory approval. Compensatory time may be carried over up until January 31st of the succeeding year adjusted to the rate of pay in effect in the preceding year.

Section 2. That except as amended by this Ordinance, Section 262.02 remains in full force and effect without change.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to provide employees who are not members of collective bargaining units the same benefits as employees who are members of collective bargaining units ~~effective January 1, 2004~~, and shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
