

ORDINANCE NO. 45-04

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with EMH&T for professional services needed to provide technical assistance to the City of Bexley with regards to implementation of a CMOM (Capacity, Maintenance, Operation and Management) Program as required by the City of Columbus, and to appropriate \$1,500.00 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund to fund such services.

Whereas, the City of Bexley will require technical assistance when meeting and negotiating with the City of Columbus with regards to the implementation of a CMOM Program; and,

Whereas, EMH&T, the City's engineers, are uniquely qualified to provide the technical assistance due to their knowledge of the City's sewer system. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$1,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for the purpose of providing the City technical assistance when meeting and negotiating with the City of Columbus with regards to the implementation of a CMOM Program.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor should be and hereby are authorized to enter into a contract with EMH&T to provide the needed technical assistance.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
