An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 19-04 to fix the annual salary of the Health Commissioner/Sanitarian at \$20,000, subject to adjust to correct an an overpayment due to a payroll error.

Whereas, since July 25, 2003, the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian have both been filled by Robert Kramer, who previously served as Sanitarian only; and

Whereas, Section 262.02(d)(3) provides that if the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian are filled by one person, he or she shall be paid only the salary of the Health Commissioner; and

Whereas, due to a payroll error, Mr. Kramer received compensation in both capacities, resulting in an overpayment; and

Whereas, the City and Mr. Kramer have agreed to resolve the matter by fixing the compensation for the combined positions at \$20,000 per year as of July 25, 2003, and to adjust his salary for the pay periods April 16 through October 29, 2004, to reimburse the City for the prior overpayment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 19-04 is hereby amended to fix the annual salary of the Health Commissioner/Sanitarian at \$20,000 as of July 25, 2003, subject to adjustment for the pay periods April 16 through October 29, 2004, in accordance with a schedule prepared by the Finance Director and approved by Mr. Kramer.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to staff the City's Health Department on an uninterrupted basis in order to provide public health services to the City's residents and businesses, and shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
