MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE CITY OF BEXLEY (City")

AND

THE OHIO COUNCIL 8 AND LOCAL 3838 OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, AFL-CIO ("Union")

AGREEMENT TO PERMIT CITY EMPLOYEES TO BE PAID FOR TIME WORKED OUT OF CLASSIFICATION

Pursuant to agreement of the parties, this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is hereby incorporated into the current Collective Bargaining Agreements ("Agreement") between the City and the Union.

Article 19 Working Out of Classification / Temporary Transfers of the Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be amended by addition as follows:

<u>Section 19.1. Working out of Classification.</u> A bargaining unit member who is required to accept responsibilities and carry out duties of a position or classification above that which he or she normally holds for a period of eight (8) consecutive hours or more shall be paid at the rate of that position. If the position for which the bargaining unit member is accepting responsibility for and carrying out the duties thereof is a supervisory position, the number of consecutive work hours required for the additional pay shall be reduced to three and one half (3 1/2) consecutive hours or more.

The intent of the parties is to pay bargaining unit members for work they perform as a supervisor in the absence of their supervisor.
