

ORDINANCE NO. 61-04

An Ordinance to accept a Columbus Urban Area Security Initiative (USASI) grant in the amount of \$236,000 for upgrade of the City's police radio system, to appropriate, subject to receipt of the grant, up to \$236,000 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of 20 car radios, 35 portable radios and a radio console and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into contracts on behalf of the City for such purpose.

WHEREAS, the City applied for and has been awarded a grant of \$236,000 from the Columbus Urban Area Security Initiative (USASI) for the upgrade of the City's police radio system;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City hereby accepts the Columbus Urban Area Security Initiative (USASI) grant in the amount of \$236,000 for upgrade of the City's police radio system.

Section 2. That, subject to receipt of the grant, up to \$236,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purchase of 20 car radios, 35 portable radios and a radio console in accordance with the terms and conditions of the grant.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute one or more contracts on behalf of the City for the purchase of such radio equipment, which contracts shall, to the extent required by law, be with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement and bidding.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
