A Resolution creating the Land Use Strategy—Alum Creek Corridor Committee.

WHEREAS, the Bexley Land Use Strategy Commission identified the Alum Creek Corridor as a priority area worthy of further study and a specific development strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Corridor is currently underutilized and has the potential to attract more people for recreational purposes, while protecting a vital resource in the community; and

WHEREAS, a committee of individuals have come together to address these concerns and develop a land use plan, as well as seek funding for the Corridor; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That there is hereby created the Land Use Strategy—Alum Creek Corridor Committee consisting of up to fifteen (15) members to further study the Alum Creek Corridor, develop a land use plan, and seek sources of funding to implement such a plan.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
