

ORDINANCE 13-11

An ordinance to provide a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) shall be prepared for all projects wherein the associated construction activities will result in one or more acres of land disturbance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1. The SWP3 shall conform to any and all standards defined in the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Authorization for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activity under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, (permit number OHC000003); effective April 21, 2008, and all revisions and amendments thereto.

Section 2. The Notice of Intent, as well as a copy of the SWP3 shall be provided to the City for review prior to the commencement of construction activities. Such erosion and sediment control devices, techniques and other measures shall not be removed and/or disturbed until earth disturbing activities on each applicable site have been concluded and the disturbed areas permanently stabilized.


Section 3. Erosion and sediment control techniques will be inspected by the City to ensure compliance with the Ohio EPA's Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) General Permit. Failure to maintain erosion and sedimentation control measures as approved by the City is a violation of this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


