

Amended Ordinance 29-11

An Ordinance enacting new Chapter 446 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley, Ohio, to provide for the operation of golf carts upon public streets.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is necessary to enact new Chapter 446 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley, Ohio to provide for the operation of golf carts upon public streets within the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. There is hereby enacted new Chapter 446 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley, Ohio, which shall read as follows:

**CHAPTER 446
GOLF CARTS**

446.01 Definitions

**446.02 Usage and Restrictions
Penalty**

446.01 DEFINITIONS

- (a) "Vehicle" has the same meaning as set forth in R.C. 4501.01(A).
- (b) "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as set forth in R.C. 4501.01(B).
- (c) "Operator" has the same meaning as set forth in R.C. 4501.01(X).
- (d) "Golf Cart" is a motor vehicle as that term is defined under R.C. 4501.01(B).

446.02 USAGE AND RESTRICTIONS

No golf carts shall be permitted to travel on any city street where the speed limit is greater than 25 mph. Golf carts will be permitted to cross intersections with higher speeds, so long as they continue upon a street having a speed limit of 25

mps or less. No person shall operate a golf cart on a public sidewalk or other leisure path.

446.04 The operator of a golf cart on the streets and alleys of Bexley, Ohio shall be required to follow all traffic regulations.

446.99 PENALTY


Whoever violates this Chapter is guilty of a minor misdemeanor on a first offense, on a second offense ~~(within one year after the first offense)~~, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; and ~~each subsequent offense~~ ^{for} ~~(within one year after the first offense)~~ the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
