

RESOLUTION NO. 01 -12

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Bexley (the "Applicant") to submit an application for a grant to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation for funding the preparation of a Safe Routes to School Travel Plan (the "Project"), and authorizing the Mayor to sign all appropriate documents on behalf of the Applicant in accordance with the application for, and acceptance of, such grant.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has set aside monies for the Safe Routes to School Projects through the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, applicants can apply for these monies and be selected for funding by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the School Travel Plan is an activity eligible to receive federal transportation funding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized on behalf of the Applicant to prepare and execute an application for SRTS School Travel Plan Development for the stated described project and to submit same to the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.


Section 2. If awarded the project, no funding will be reimbursed to the Applicant for School Travel Plan Development. The Applicant will be asked to provide information, develop a team, and work with ODOT on plan development. The Applicant further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost over and above the work provided by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation.

Section 3. Upon completion of the described Project, the Applicant shall provide the completed School Travel Plan with adequate community endorsements.


Section 4. If the application is approved for the STP Development the Mayor of the Applicant is hereby empowered on behalf of the Applicant to enter into a contract with the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

Section 5. That this Resolution shall go into full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
