

ORDINANCE 53 -12

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and the Chief of Police of the City of Bexley, Ohio to enter into a labor agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police/Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (F.O.P./O.L.C.) for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015, covering the Police Dispatchers and Animal Control Officers.

WHEREAS, the labor contract between the City of Bexley, Ohio and the F.O.P./O.L.C. will expire on December 31, 2012, and

WHEREAS, negotiations between the City of Bexley, Ohio and the F.O.P./O.L.C. have resulted in a tentative agreement with the members of the F.O.P./O.L.C., and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Bexley, Ohio to provide for the safety and well-being of its citizens, to have a labor agreement with its dispatchers and animal control officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That the Mayor, City Attorney and Chief of Police of the City of Bexley, Ohio are hereby authorized to enter into a labor agreement on behalf of the City with the F.O.P./O.L.C. for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest time allowed by law.


