

ORDINANCE NO. 116-05

An Ordinance to appropriate \$15,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay expenses relating to a lead-based paint assessment of Jeffrey Mansion and the relocation of the Recreation Department to a temporary structure during the closure of Jeffrey Mansion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$15,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay expenses relating to a lead-based paint assessment of Jeffrey Mansion and the relocation of the Recreation Department to a temporary structure during the closure of Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
