

ORDINANCE NO. 13 -05

An Ordinance to establish fees for fingerprint services provided by the Bexley Police Department.

Whereas, the Bexley Police Department provides fingerprint service to the general public for the purpose of employment and criminal history checks, and

Whereas, the number of print cards completed the past two calendar years has exceeded 600 cards per year, and

Whereas, the ever increasing demand for fingerprint services makes it necessary to establish a fee to help control cost and manage resources dedicated to providing this service to the public. **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. The fee established for fingerprint services provided by the Bexley Police Department, for employment and criminal history checks, will be set at \$10.00 per card. The Bexley Police Department will establish the policies and procedures related to the fingerprint services, including the hours and days of the week during which fingerprint services will be available to the general public.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
