WHEREAS, on June 2, 2005, the Franklin County Auditor certified to the Council that the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal tax levy during the first year of collection is \$308,320.66, based on the current assessed valuation of the City of \$391,165,716;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, two-thirds of all of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Council desires to proceed with the submission of the question of the renewal tax levy to the electors of the City.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The question of such renewal tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of the City at the election to be held therein on November 8, 2005 (the "Election Date").
- Section 3. The form of the ballot to be used at said election shall be substantially as follows:

"A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio for the purpose of **current expenses** of the City at a rate not exceeding three and four tenths (3.4) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to thirty-four cents (\$0.34) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for the following period of time: five years, commencing in 2005, first due in calendar year 2006.


