Section 1. That the amount of \$25,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring a consultant to prepare a comprehensive park plan for the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
