An Ordinance to appropriate \$193,049.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing needed equipment for the Service Department.

*Whereas*, it has been determined that the following equipment is needed for Service Department operations: one chipper truck (\$43,000.00); one leaf loader (\$16,000.00); one skid steer loader and grinder (\$33,000.00); two pick-up trucks (\$32,000.00); one paver box (\$48,000.00); five chain saws (\$2,000.00); one hot box (\$15,595.00); one snow plow blade (\$2,500.00.00) and one partner saw (\$950.00), at a cost of \$193,049.00, and


*Whereas*, it is necessary to transfer the needed funds from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund to enable the purchases, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the amount of \$193,049.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of purchasing needed equipment for the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force form the earliest period allowed by law.
