

ORDINANCE NO. 37 -05

An ordinance to appropriate \$4,375.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for the programming of the new 800 MHz radios. The City of Columbus, Division of Communications will program the primary 800 MHz channels on the new radios for the total cost of \$1,775. The fee for programming the Ohio MARCS channels into the new radios will cost a total of \$2,600. The total cost for all programming will be \$4,375.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY**

Section 1. That \$4,375.00 from the unencumbered General Fund be appropriated for the purpose of paying for the programming of the new 800 MHz radios by the Columbus Division of Communications and Ohio MARCS.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
