An Ordinance to establish a charge of \$30.00 for a Water Department Fire Hydrant Permit to allow for the use of city water hydrants and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the start of large construction projects within the City has established a need for a supplying water to the projects on a temporary basis, and

Whereas, the most expedient method of providing the water is through City hydrants, and

Whereas, it is necessary to establish a permitting process to control the use. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the charge of \$30.00 should be and hereby is established for a - inmediate preservation Water Department Fire Hydrant Permit.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to supply projects under construction with water, and shall become effective upon its signing by the Mayor.
