A Ordinance authorizing the Building Services Director to hire one full time personnel needed to maintain the Code Enforcement Department from the previously approved staffing level ~~of part-time employee~~ and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Council has previously placed a freeze on hiring by all departments; and,

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Department has a vacant position and this Council has determined that it is in the public interest to maintain the Code Enforcement Department at one full-time employee. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Building Services Director is hereby authorized to hire personnel needed to maintain the Code Enforcement Department at the previously approved staffing level ~~of a part-time employee~~.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to restore the Department to its authorized staffing level at the earliest possible date, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
