

ORDINANCE NO. 11 -06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$30,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying a portion of the City's share of street and landscape improvements for East Main Street between Alum Creek Drive and Parkview Avenue (also known as Pump House Park), and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley has received Federal Transportation Enhancement Funds in the amount of \$341,000, and

WHEREAS, the City's local match is \$82,060, and

WHEREAS, the City currently has \$53,884.50 appropriated for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, the outstanding amount will be reimbursed by private contributions, NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$30,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying a portion of the City's share City's of street and landscape improvements for East Main Street between Alum Creek Drive and Parkview Avenue (also known as Pump House Park).

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public health and welfare, said emergency being the need to submit the City's local share to the Ohio Department of Transportation so that the project can be bid for a spring start, and shall go into effect upon its signing by the Mayor.
