

ORDINANCE NO. 13-06

An Ordinance to amend Subsection (d) of Section 832.01, of Chapter 8, Business Regulation & Taxation, of the Bexley Codified Ordinances. The purpose of the amendment to Section 832.01 is to clarify existing language pertaining to age requirements of applicants for a solicitor's license.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That subsection (d) of Section 832.01, be amended to read as follows:

(d) The Chief or officer in charge may issue a license to such applicant after consideration of the application and the results of any investigation, if such applicant is of full age, has a good reputation, has no criminal record, is not and has not engaged in fraudulent activities and will comply with the laws of the State and the City. However, a license may be issued to an applicant under eighteen years of age if such applicant is a resident of the City.

Section 2. That Subsection (d) of Section 832.01 of Chapter 8, Business Regulation & Taxation, of the Bexley Codified Ordinances as presently in effect is hereby repealed and that the remaining Subsections of said Section 832.01 shall remain in full force and effect without amendment.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
