An Ordinance to appropriate \$5,500.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing an electric valve operator for the purpose of assisting in the turning of water valves within the City and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$5,500.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing an electric valve operator for the purpose of assisting in the turning of water valves within the City and to declare an emergency.

Section 2. That this is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the protection of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to operate valves as part of the City's ongoing leak detection program *and shall be in effect from and after passage and approval by the Mayor.*
