

ORDINANCE NO. 23-06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$20,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund, \$20,000.00 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund, \$5,000.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund and \$3,500.00 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for the purpose of relocating data network wiring to protect the City's data and telephone network and operations from damaging weather, lightning and potential acts of terrorism.

Whereas, the City's data network is critical to the operation of the City; and,

Whereas, the wiring for the system is currently vulnerable to damaging weather, lightning, and potential acts of terrorism. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amounts of \$20,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund, \$20,000.00, from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund, \$5,000.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund and \$3,500.00 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund should be and hereby are appropriated for the purpose of relocating data network wiring to protect the City's data and telephone network and operations from damaging weather, lightning and potential acts of terrorism.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance, said emergency being the need to protect the City's data and telephone network from damaging weather, lightning and potential acts of terrorism and will take effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
