

ORDINANCE NO. 30-06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$12,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund to provide upgraded electric, alarm system, accessibility upgrades and interior painting, flooring and carpeting for the property known as Clifton House on the Jeffrey mansion property for the purpose of providing a space for the Bexley Historical Office and display of historical items and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the Bexley Historical Society is a valued member of the Bexley Community; and,

Whereas, the Clifton House is currently vacant and fulfills the Bexley Historical Society's need for space. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$12,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to provide upgraded electric, alarm system, accessibility upgrades and interior painting, flooring and carpeting for the property known as Clifton House on the Jeffrey Mansion property for the purpose of providing a space for the Bexley Historical Office and display of historical items.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is any emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare and safety, the emergency being the need for the Bexley Historical Society to vacate the office space they currently occupy in Bexley City Hall to provide an office for the City's Director of Information Systems, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
