

**ORDINANCE NO. 34-06**

An Ordinance to appropriate \$2,993.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of replacing the air conditioning unit which serves the north wing of Bexley City Hall and to declare an emergency.

*Whereas*, the air conditioning unit that serves the north wing of Bexley City Hall is nonfunctional and cannot be repaired, and,

*Whereas*, it is essential to replace the unit prior to the cooling season. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That the amount of \$2,993.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of replacing the air conditioning unit which serves the north wing of Bexley City Hall.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the public safety and welfare, the emergency being the need to provide air conditioning to the north wing in time for the cooling season, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
