

ORDINANCE NO. 37-06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$190,000.00 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund to fund various sewer improvement projects for the year 2006 and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, several important sewer line improvements have been identified by the city's engineers, and,

Whereas, the projects should be accomplished in the year 2006. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$190,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund to fund various sewer improvement projects for the year 2006.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest and best bidder, after bidding in accordance with law, for the work determined by the city's engineers, and in accordance with the Sanitary Sewer System Evaluation, dated March, 2004, to be the next phase of the City's Sanitary Sewer improvements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, said emergency being the need to accomplish the projects in the summer and fall construction season, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
