

ORDINANCE NO. 40-06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$90,000.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring the City's engineers, EMH&T, to develop a Pavement Management Program for the City.

Whereas, Bexley City Council has directed the City's Service Director to provide a 10 Year Street Program to Council; and,

Whereas, the purpose of the 10 Year Street Program is to provide City Council with the information needed to potentially develop an accelerated street program utilizing bonds; and,

Whereas, the City's engineers EMH&T have provided a proposal which will accomplish the above. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$90,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of hiring the City's engineers, EMH&T, to develop a Pavement Management Program for the City.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the proposal, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this Ordinance, with EMH&T.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
