An Ordinance to appropriate ^{1,920,000} ~~\$2,200,000~~ from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of renovating the City swimming pool and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for such project, ~~subject to the further approval of City Council.~~

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That ^{1,920,000} ~~\$2,200,000~~ is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of renovating the City swimming pool ~~X.~~

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City ~~provided, however, that the Board of Control shall not select a successful bidder and no construction contract shall be entered into with respect to the project unless this Council shall by motion give its further approval to the project.~~

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
