

ORDINANCE NO. 43 - 06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$7,110.00 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying Independence Communications for a one year extended warranty on certain items related to the Police Department's Mobile Data Terminal system.

Whereas, the existing MDT system was obtained through Federal COPS More funding and the city is obligated, by grant agreement, to maintain the equipment in an operational status, and;

Whereas, the MDT system must be maintained in an operable condition to allow the Police Department to comply with grant reporting requirements, and

Whereas, the existing system is in need of maintenance and systems updates to keep it functional;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That \$7,110.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying Independence Communications for a one year extended warranty on the Police Department's Mobile Data Terminal system as follows:
