

ORDINANCE NO. 66 -06

An Ordinance to establish four funds for the receipt of contributions in support of community enhancement projects and to appropriate monies therefrom as received for projects approved by the Tree and Public Gardens Commission or the Mayor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That four operating funds be established for the receipt of contributions in support of purposes designated for each of them as follows:

Trees for Bexley Fund – Restoration and replenishment of trees on public property and rights-of way

Bexley in Bloom Fund – Seasonal displays of bulbs and flowers on public property and rights-of-way, including Drexel Circle, gateways to the City and the East Broad Street and East Main Street bridges

Bexley Beautification Fund – Design, installation and maintenance of projects enhancing the physical environment, including Drexel Circle, gateways, parks and other public grounds

Bexley Banner Fund – Design, installation and maintenance of street banners

Section 2. That contributions deposited to each of such funds shall be deemed appropriated upon the written authorization of the Tree and Public Gardens Commission or the Mayor.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
