

ORDINANCE NO. 94 -06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$1,580,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of renovating the City swimming pool pump and bathhouses and to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for such project, subject to the further approval of City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$1,580,000 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the costs of renovating the City swimming pool pump and bathhouses.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City; provided, however, that the Board of Control shall not select a successful bidder and no construction contract shall be entered into with respect to the project unless this Council shall by motion give its further approval to the project.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
