

ORDINANCE NO. 98-06

An Ordinance to appropriate \$43,000.00 from the unencumbered Sewer Fund and \$43,000.00 from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing a dump truck with hydraulic equipment for the purpose of use in the Service Department.

Whereas, a 1990 dump truck currently in use in the Service Department is incurring costly maintenance and is unreliable; and,

Whereas, it is necessary to replace the truck to keep the number of trucks needed available. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$43,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund and \$43,000.00 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered Water Fund for the purpose of purchasing a dump truck with hydraulic equipment for the purpose of use in the Service Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at earliest period allowed by law.
