

RESOLUTION NO. 8 - 07

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into negotiations for the lease of a facility for the relocation of the existing Service Garage and its ancillary uses and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of City Council to relocate the Service Garage and its ancillary uses from its current location at 2242 East Main Street to facilitate the redevelopment of that site for civic uses; and

WHEREAS, the location of the proposed new Police Department facility is the same as the existing Service Garage which necessitates the expeditious moving of the Service Garage; and


WHEREAS, several facilities in the immediate vicinity of Bexley are available and would provide service facilities at a level of or better than the existing facilities;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO;

Section 1. That the Mayor should be and hereby is authorized to enter into negotiations for the lease of a facility for the relocation of the existing Service Garage and its ancillary uses; provided that said lease shall be subject to approval by Council.

Section 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity of relocating the Service Garage as soon as possible to facilitate the construction of a new Police Department, and shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
