WHEREAS, the Friends of Alum Creek & Tributaries ("FACT") group has completed the Lower Alum Creek Watershed Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, this plan was created with the help of watershed communities, including the City of Bexley; and

WHEREAS, the Plan defines actions that can be taken to improve and protect the health of Alum Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Plan supports the efforts the City is undertaking through two Clean Ohio grants along Alum Creek to do creekside land preservation by removing invasive species and reforesting with native species; and

WHEREAS, the Plan creates better recreational access, urban runoff education, dam removal to accomplish creek restoration, and proves multi-use trail signage that will benefit the city;


WHEREAS, the City of Bexley in an in-kind partner for removal of the upstream dams; NOW, THEREFORE,
