

ORDINANCE NO. 100-07

By: Matthew Lampke:

An ordinance to appropriate \$ 45,023.87 unencumbered General Fund, \$5,980 from the Street Fund, \$2,899.64 from the Recreation Fund, \$76.59 from the Water Fund and \$2,381.13 from the Sewer Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$45,023.87 is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.

Section 2. That \$5,980.00 is appropriated from the Street Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.


Section 3. That \$2,899.64 is appropriated from the Recreation Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.

Section 4. That \$76.59 is appropriated from the Water Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.

Section 5. That \$2,381.13 is appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purpose of paying for employee health insurance for the remainder of 2007.


Section 6. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
