A Resolution adopting the recommendations of the Bexley Tax Incentive Review Council regarding two tax-abated properties on East Main Street.

WHEREAS, under O.R.C. Section 3735.67, the owners of two properties on East Main Street have submitted applications for, and been granted, tax abatements on real property improvements; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Shoppes of Bexley (Parcel Nos. 020-001533 and 020-001534 aka 2396-2408 East Main Street) is MRMJ LLC and the property was granted a tax abatement under Ordinance 46-05; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Chase Bank building (Parcel No. 020-000084 aka 2656-2660 East Main Street) is Metropolitan Bexley LLC and the property was granted a tax abatement under Ordinance 110-05; and

WHEREAS, each of these properties has been granted a real property tax abatement by City Council for a 5-year term, beginning at 100% and declining by 20% each year thereafter until their expirations; and

WHEREAS, the Main Street Community Redevelopment Area Housing Council and the Housing Officer have inspected these properties; and

WHEREAS, the Bexley Tax Incentive Review Council has reviewed the tax abatement agreements and financial and job commitments contained in those agreements versus progress made toward achieving those commitments; and

WHEREAS, the Development Director, on behalf of the Bexley Tax Incentive Review Council forwarded the Council's recommendations to Bexley City Council on August 13, 2007;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the existing tax abatements for these two properties shall be continued for the terms and percentages specified in the original tax abatement agreements, such terms being for 5 years (expiring at the end of 2011) and beginning at 100% and declining by 20% each year thereafter until the expiration.

Section 2. This Resolution shall go into full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
