ORDINANCE NO.3/- 07

An Ordinance to transfer \$25,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund and to appropriate \$25,000 from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of replacing the city's telephone system, and to declarean emergency.

Whereas, the city's current telephone system is antiquated and frail; and,

Whereas, the city's current telephone system lacks the ability to provide adequate assistance to serve public safety during an emergency; and,

Whereas, the city staff members should be empowered to work more efficiently; and,

Whereas, the residents will benefit from improved call management within operations of the city's administrative staff. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1: That the amount of \$25,000 should be and hereby is transferred from theunencumbered General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund and \$25,000 is appropriated from the unencumbered Capital Improvements Fund for the purpose of replacing the city's telephone system.

shall be effective from and after the earliest pinal allowed by Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the laws O protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, said emergency being the need to replace the city's antiquated telephone system to ensure that it will not fail, and shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
