

ORDINANCE NO. 34 - 07

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a series of transactions on behalf of the City relating to the lease, installation, maintenance and operation of a new telephone system for the City, and to declare an emergency

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a series of transactions on behalf of the City, relating to the lease, installation, maintenance and operation of a new telephone system for the City, including, but not limited to, a Master Tax-Exempt Lease/Purchase Agreement between the City and Key Government Finance, Inc. at an estimated cost of \$1,950 per month for five years, an installation agreement by and between the City and NeTeam Systems at an estimated cost of \$16,500, a maintenance plan through NeTeam Systems provided by Cisco SMARTnet Service at an estimated cost of \$9,300 per year and an agreement for voice services by and between the City and XO Communications Services, Inc. at an estimated cost of \$1,500 per month, all in forms approved by the City Attorney.

Section 2. That, to the extent required by law, such contracts shall be with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to replace the City's telephone system at the earliest practicable date to assure uninterrupted services to the residents of the City and general public, and shall be effective upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
