

ORDINANCE NO. 50 - 07

An Ordinance to abolish the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian, to amend Section 262.02(d) of the Administrative Code, Section 272.02(c) of the Administrative Code, Chapter 820 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code and Second Amended Ordinance No. 91-06 and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it would be in the best interests of the City and its residents to contract with the Franklin County Board of Health for all public health services within the City; and

WHEREAS, upon the effective date of said contract, it will no longer be necessary for the City to have a Health Commissioner or Sanitarian;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian are hereby abolished.

Section 2. That Section 262.02(d) of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by deleting subdivisions (3) and (4).

Section 3. That, as amended by Section 2 above, Section 262.02(d) of the Administrative Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. That Section 272.02(c) of the Administrative Code is hereby amended as follows:

(c) The Board shall appoint a Health Commissioner who shall serve as the Secretary of the Board; provided, however, that notwithstanding the foregoing, the City may contract for all public health services, including the services of a health commissioner, with the board of health of another jurisdiction. In the event that the City contracts for public health services, the Board shall not appoint a Health Commissioner and the duties of Health Commissioner and Secretary of the Board shall be performed by the contracting entity and its designated officials. In the event that the City shall contract with the board of health of another jurisdiction to provide all public health services of the City, for purposes of this Chapter "Health Commissioner" shall mean the contracting entity and its designated officials.

Section 5. That, as amended by Section 4 above, Section 272.02 of the Administrative Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. That Chapter 820 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code is hereby amended by the adoption of a new Section 820.08 as follows:

820.08 HEALTH COMMISSIONER DEFINED.

In the event that the City shall contract with the board of health of another jurisdiction as provided in Section 272.02 of the Administrative Code to provide all public health services of the City, for purposes of this Chapter "Health Commissioner" shall mean the contracting entity and its designated officials.

Section 7. That, as amended by Section 6 above, Chapter 820 of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8. That Second Amended Ordinance No. 91-06 is hereby amended by deleting all references to the positions of Health Commissioner and Sanitarian.

Section 9. That, as amended by Section 8 above, Second Amended Ordinance No. 91-06 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 10. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety or welfare, said emergency being the need to commence the public health services of the Franklin County Board of Health as soon as possible, and shall be in effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor and upon the effective date of the contract between the City and the Franklin County Board of Health.


