

ORDINANCE NO. 53 -07

An Ordinance to appropriate \$62,437 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of making upgrades to the City's street lighting system, said repairs being the replacement of splice box lids, and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the City is developing a phased program of upgrading its street lighting system; and,

Whereas, the second phase consists of replacing approximately ⁴⁷⁸ ~~2~~ pull splice box lids in the City's street lighting system. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of \$62,437 should be and hereby is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of making upgrades to the City's street lighting system, said repairs being the replacement of splice box lids.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare, said emergency being the need to immediately replace ~~2~~ pull boxes to insure their safety, and shall go into force and be in effect upon its signing by the Mayor.
