An Ordinance to appropriate ~~\$130,000.00~~ from the unencumbered General Fund for Phase II of the Street Lighting System Upgrade Program.

Whereas, the City has entered into a program of upgrading its 30 year old street lighting system; and,

Whereas, the next phase of the project is the inspection and repair, as needed, of all splice boxes and the wiring within the splice boxes, and the installation of replacement lids and locking hardware. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the amount of ~~\$130,000.00~~ ^{\$100,000.00} is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for Phase II of the Street Lighting System Upgrade Program.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
