

ORDINANCE NO. 40-08

An ordinance to appropriate \$105,245 from the unencumbered General Fund for the purpose of paying for design fees to Horne and King and EMH&T related to the relocation of the police station to the Delmar Avenue site, to pay for landscape architecture related to the new police station and to incorporate LEED standards into the design of the new police station.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1. That \$105,245 is appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund as follows:

Incorporate LEED standards into police station design	\$ 20,150
Design services for relocation to Delmar site	\$ 81,095
Landscape architecture for new police station	<u>\$ 4,000</u>
Total	\$105,245

Section 2. This Council reasonably expects that the capital and other expenditures described in Section 1 (the "Project") will be reimbursed with the proceeds of "bonds" (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the Project is \$ 6,600,000

Section 3 That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
