

ORDINANCE 04-09

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor of the City of Bexley, Ohio or his designated representative to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency regarding the investigation and repair of all sanitary sewer systems connected to the City of Columbus' sewer system.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) entered into a consent order with the City of Columbus requiring Columbus to properly operate and maintain its wastewater treatment system; and

WHEREAS, Columbus cannot fully comply with this order unless it has accurate information about sanitary flow and clear water infiltration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the OEPA is requiring satellite communities to comply with the Director's Final Finding and Orders; and


Section 2. That it is hereby ordained that the Mayor of the City of Bexley, Ohio is authorized by this Council to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency accepting the Director's Final Findings and Orders for satellite communities relating to the investigation and repair of all of the sanitary sewer systems connected to the City of Columbus' sewer system; and


Section 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and

Section 4. That is Ordinance is declared an emergency.
