The resolution must be voted on and adopted by your respective governing body and returned to this office on or before the first day of October. (O.R.C. 5705.34) The amounts on this resolution include the real property state reimbursement for rollback and homestead. In the event your subdivision passes a levy in November and/or has a bond rate to be set by the Budget Commission, an "Amended Resolution Accepting the Amounts and Rates Authorizing Necessary Tax Levies" will be forwarded to you in late December.

The Real Estate & Public Utility tax levy revenue estimates appearing on your Official Certificate are based on 2008 valuation data and new construction as of January 1, 2009. The revenue estimates for the Personal Property tax levy are based upon the information as supplied by the State of Ohio located on their website. The Official Certificate takes into account the "make whole" provisions as provided by the Ohio Department of Taxation.

Levies expiring in 2009 have been removed. Levies to be voted on in November 2009 are not included.

It should be noted that current tax revenue estimates may increase or decrease when actual valuation and effective tax rate data become available in December.
