WHEREAS, This Council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously
adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, has certified its
action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of
each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what
part within, the ten mill tax limitation; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Council of the City of BEXLEY
Franklin County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget
Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted: and be it further

RESOLVED, That there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said City



The resolution must be voted on and adopted by your respective governing body and returned to this office on or before the first day of October. (O.R.C. 5705.34) The amounts on this resolution **include** the real property state reimbursement for rollback and homestead. In the event your subdivision passes a levy in November and/or has a bond rate to be set by the Budget Commission, an "Amended Resolution Accepting the Amounts and Rates Authorizing Necessary Tax Levies" will be forwarded to you in late December.

The Real Estate & Public Utility tax levy revenue estimates appearing on your Official Certificate are based on 2008 valuation data and new construction as of January 1, 2009. The revenue estimates for the Personal Property tax levy are based upon the information as supplied by the State of Ohio located on their website. The Official Certificate takes into account the "make whole" provisions as provided by the Ohio Department of Taxation.

Levies expiring in 2009 have been removed. Levies to be voted on in November 2009 are not included.

It should be noted that current tax revenue estimates may increase or decrease when actual valuation and effective tax rate data become available in December.
