## AMENDED ORDINANCE No. 43-09

An Ordinance to revise Section 432.38 of the Bexley City Code to add sub-paragraphs a, b, and c prohibiting the use of wireless or personal communication devices on public roadways while operating a vehicle in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. The Bexley City Code 432.38 a, b, and c shall be enacted as follows:

- a. No person shall operate a vehicle on public roadways in the City of Bexley,
  Ohio while using any wireless or handheld personal communication devices to:
- 1. Manually enter letters or text messages into a device as a means of communicating with another person; or
- 2. Read any received emails or text messages transmitted to the device or stored within the device; or
- 3. Send, read, create or interact with internet based content or play games.
- b. This provision shall not apply to emergency vehicles or to any person reporting a health or safety emergency.
- c. This violation will be considered a primary offense.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this Ordinance shall go into effect, and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
