

ORDINANCE NO. 45-09

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor or his designated appointee to enter into an agreement with Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. to be the sole provider of solid waste, recyclable materials and yard waste collection services for waste generated by residential units, municipal facilities and during special events in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 715.43 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City may establish such collection systems and designate solid waste facilities as may be necessary or appropriate to provide for the safe and sanitary management of Solid Waste, including Recyclable Materials and Yard Waste, generated within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its Residents that the City arrange for the collection, transportation and delivery for disposal or processing of all Solid Waste, Recyclable Materials and Yard Waste generated within the City; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2009, and on February 26, 2009, the City, as part of a Joint Bid Process with several communities located within the jurisdiction of the Solid Waste Authority of Central Ohio ("2009 Solid Waste Consortium"), invited through advertisement in the Columbus Dispatch qualified providers of the Collection Services to submit bids to provide such Collection Services on the terms and conditions contained in the Collection Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, prior to the official opening of the bids by the 2009 Solid Waste Consortium and consideration of all bids for Collection Services, the City determined that the Contractor is qualified to provide the Collection Services to the City; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2009, the Contractor submitted an alternate bid to become the sole provider of Collection Services for the benefit of the City and its Residents that is intended to encourage increased recycling in the City; and

WHEREAS, the alternate bid is based upon using the same recycling service as presently performed and current recycling containers, rendering exclusive facilities awards unnecessary; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the alternative bid submitted by the Contractor will encourage increased recycling in the City by securing unlimited delivery and processing of Recyclable Materials with no fee for the life of the Collection Agreement, among other benefits; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor negotiated and agreed upon terms and conditions for performance of the Collection Services in conformance with Exhibit A, the Collection Services Agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Bexley, Ohio does hereby authorized the Service Director to enter into an Agreement with Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. that is substantially in accordance with Exhibit A.

This Ordinance will go into effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
