ORDINANCE NO. 39-09

An Ordinance to create a special fund designated the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund and to authorize a transfer of \$5,000 from the General Fund to the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund. The Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund shall be administered by the Chief of Police and be noted as a line item in the Police Annual Budget. The fund shall be used to allow Police Officers to purchase equipment, authorized by the Chief of Police, for duty use. The Police Officers shall then repay the purchase price back into the fund over a twelve month period by payroll deductions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

- Section 1. That a special fund designated the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund is hereby established to assist Police Officers in purchasing equipment for duty use, as authorized by the Chief of Police.
- Section 2. That the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund shall be administered by the Chief of Police and be noted as a line item in the Annual Police Budget.
- Section 3. That Police Officers using the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund to purchase authorized equipment shall have twelve months to repay the fund by payroll deductions, with further provision that a Police Officer shall repay any balance due to the fund by one final payroll deduction, if he or she leaves Bexley Police employment before twelve months have elapsed.
- Section 4. That a transfer of \$5,000 is hereby authorized from the General Fund to the Police Officer Equipment Purchase Fund.
- Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
