

ORDINANCE 45-10

An Ordinance to amend Bexley City Code Section 618.20(a) maximum number of dogs and cats permitted to include chickens, and to raise the total number of dogs, cats and chickens permitted to five (5).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That a new Bexley City Code Section 618.20(a) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 618.20 Maximum Number of Dogs, Cats and Chickens Permitted.”

(a) No person shall keep more than five dogs, cats and chickens of which not more than three may be dogs, excluding puppies and/or kittens less than six months old, in any single-family dwelling, or in any separate dwelling unit in a two-family or multifamily dwelling within the City. “Dwelling” and “dwelling unit” as used in this section, include the lot or parcel of land on which the house or building containing the dwelling unit is located, and all other structures located on the lot or parcel.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


