

ORDINANCE NO. 02-10

An Ordinance to amend Codified Ordinance 1060.105(b) of the City of Bexley, Ohio to read as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

1060.105 CHARGES TO SENIOR CITIZENS

(a) The refuse collection charges set forth in Section 1060.10(a) shall not apply to those senior citizens who are residents of the City of Bexley and occupy a Bexley residence, who maintain Bexley utility and refuse accounts in their own names for such residences, who are sixty (60) years of age or older, and who make application to the City Water Department for exemption from the refuse collection charges set forth in Section 1060.10(a).

(b) Senior citizens who meet all of the requirements set forth in subsection (a) hereof shall be billed for refuse charges at the rate of two **hundred seventy-six dollars (\$276.00)** per year, payable quarterly in advance.

(c) Senior citizens who meet all of the requirements set forth in subsection (a) hereof and are 65 years of age by January 1, 2010, shall be billed for refuse charges at the rate of one hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$198.00) per year, payable quarterly in advance.

Section 2. That existing Section 1060.105(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Bexley is hereby repealed.



That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the need to implement the increase prior to the January, 2010 water billing period and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
